1. Pre-Upgrade Health Check

Node Status

- Check that all Nodes are in Ready state

```
kubectl get nodes -owide
```

- If any nodes are in NotReady, SchedulingDisabled, etc then it would be recommended to review and fix them before upgrading.

Pod Status

- Check that all pods are in Running state and the pod values are matching 1/1, 3/3, etc.

```
kubectl get pods -A
```

- If any pods are not running i.e, 0/1, 2/3, CrashLoopBackoff, Error, etc then it would be advised to review the issue and fix it prior to upgrading

Cluster Status

- Check that Kubernetes is up and running and healthy.

```
kubectl cluster-info
```

- If Kubernetes indicates that it is not healthy then review and establish where the issue is prior to upgrading.

etcd health

- etcd needs to be in a stable state prior to upgrading any issues

```
for pod in $(kubectl get pods -l component=etcd -n kube-system \
-o jsonpath='{.items[*].metadata.name}')
do
    echo "### etcd pod : ${pod} ###"
    kubectl -n kube-system exec ${pod} -- /bin/sh \
        -c "ETCDCTL_API=3 etcdctl \
        --cert=/etc/kubernetes/pki/etcd/server.crt \
        --key=/etc/kubernetes/pki/etcd/server.key \
        --cacert=/etc/kubernetes/pki/etcd/ca.crt \
        endpoint health"
done
```

- Should any other states be listed on the output then it would be advised to investigate the logs of the pod to establish the issue

Hangfire Status

- Check that Hangfire is running and there is no large amount of Enqueued Jobs
- It would be recommended to grab a screenshot of the Hangfire Dashboard prior to upgrading to check the amount processed for Deleted Jobs

- Turbine version 25.4.1
- MongoDB 7.0.24

1. SSH into any node in your deployment.
2. Scale down EKCO and kotsadm-qlite.
Note: EKCO and Kotsadm-qlite will automatically scale back up after the script in Step 3 has completed.

```
kubectl -n kurl scale deployment ekc-operator --replicas=0
```

```
kubectl -n default scale statefulsets kotsadm-qlite --replicas=0
```
3. Execute the following command to begin the Turbine Platform Installer component upgrade:

```
curl -sSL https://kurl.sh/turbine-turbine-25-5-0 | sudo bash -s ha
```


Note: If you have configured SELinux, firewall, or proxy add this to the end of the command above: `installer-spec-file=se.yaml`. The se.yaml is the installer patch file created by you as described in: <https://docs.swimlane.com/turbine-installer/overriding-installer-settings>.
4. After the install script has completed, log in to the Turbine Platform Installer dashboard (<https://<SwimlaneDNS>:8800>).
5. Go to the Version History tab and click **Check For Updates**.
6. A pop-up window appears, click **Go to the updated version** and click Configure.
7. Click **Deploy** on the new 25.5.0 version with the highest sequence number at the top of the versions list.
8. Once the Application tab shows 'Ready' your upgrade is complete.

Upgrade Turbine on Embedded Cluster Installations

Use the following instructions to upgrade this version of Swimlane on an embedded cluster installation.

Prerequisites:

- Turbine version 25.0.8
- MongoDB 7.0.19

Note: If you are already on version 25.1.2, no infrastructure upgrade is required. Proceed to step 4

kubectl -n default scale statefulsets kotsadm-qlite --replicas=0

For version 24.3.5 of the Turbine platform, if you encounter any issues with Swimlane tenant pods related to the database during a new installation, redeploy the application. No action is required if you are upgrading.

1. SSH into any node in your deployment.
2. Scale down EKCO and kotsadm-rglite.

```
kubectl -n kurl scale deployment ekc-operator --replicas=0
kubectl -n default scale statefulsets kotsadm-rglite --replicas=0
```

curl -sSL https://kurl.sh/turbine-turbine-24-3-5 | sudo bash -s ha
```

NOTE: If you have configured SELinux, add this to the end of the command above:

```
installer-spec-file=se.yaml
```

- Turbine version 23.2.x+
- MongoDB 5.0.14

Upgrade Instructions

1. SSH into any node in your deployment.
2. Scale down EKCO and kotsadm-rglite.

```
kubectl scale statefulsets kotsadm-rglite --replicas=0 -n default
```

```
kubectl scale deployment ekc-operator --replicas=0 -n kurl
```

3. Execute the following command to begin the Turbine Platform Installer component upgrade:

```
$ curl -sSL https://kurl.sh/turbine-turbine-23-5-1 | sudo bash -s ha
```

4. After the install script has completed, log in to the Turbine Platform Installer dashboard (<https://<SwimlaneDNS>:8800>).
5. Go to the Version History tab and click Check For Updates.
6. A pop-up window appears, click **Go to updated version** and click configure.
7. Scroll down to Swimlane Logging Level and change default, warn, to info and then save.
8. Click **Deploy** on the new 23.5.1 version with the highest sequence number at the top of the versions list.
9. Once the Application tab shows 'Ready' your upgrade is complete.
